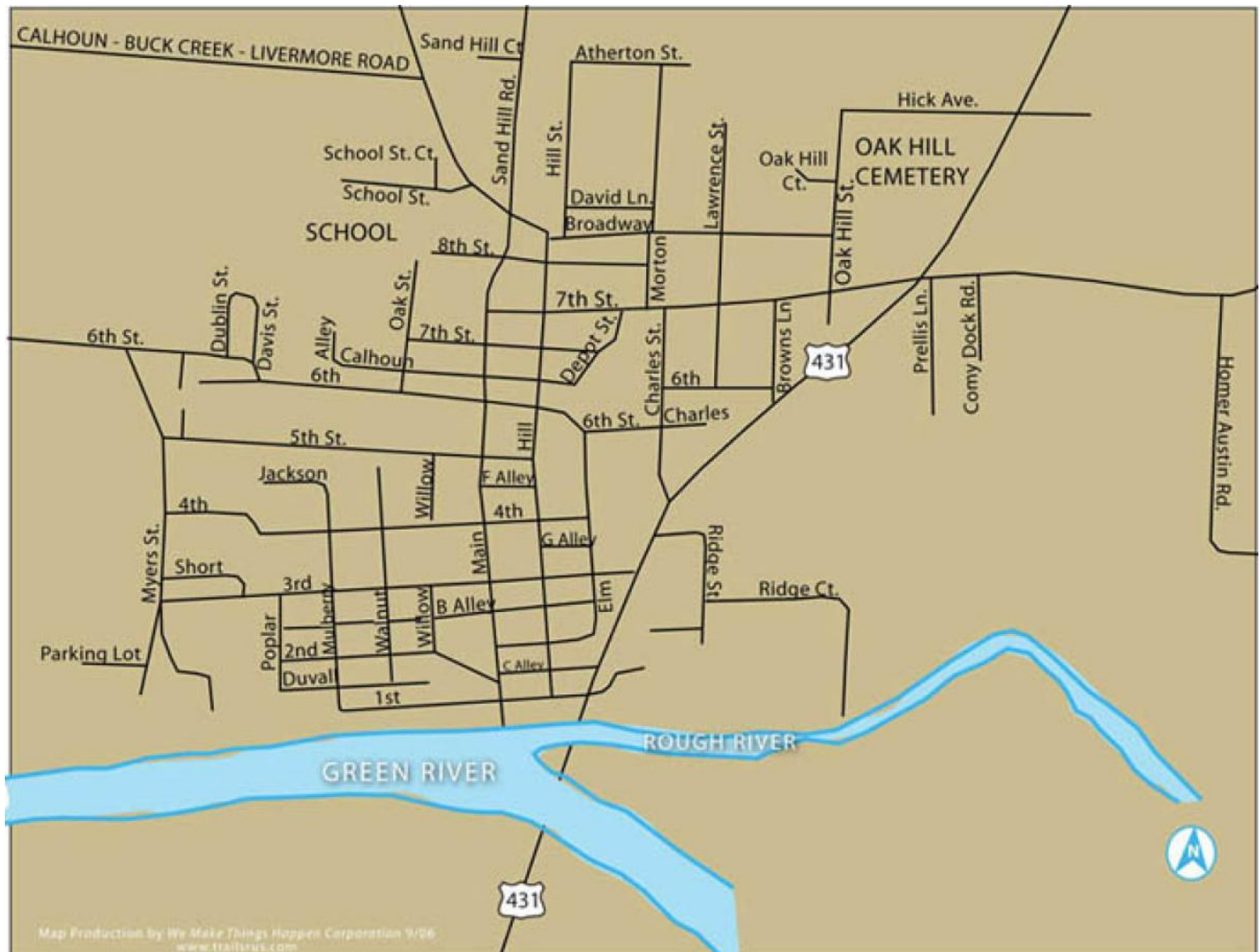


Livermore
